**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
AS A RESULT OF COVID-19**

WHEREAS, the Governor has issued an Emergency Disaster Declaration as a result of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County Commissioners have declared a state of emergency for Lawrence County as a result of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, the Neshannock Township Board of Supervisors previously declared an emergency as a result of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has announced through the Governor's Proclamation statewide mitigation to help stop the spread of COVID-19, to include suspension of non-essential services.

WHEREAS, Neshannock Township is responsible to govern and ensure essential services such as police, fire, emergency services, water, sanitation, trash collection, zoning, code enforcement and maintenance of Township roads must continue.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the undersigned Board of Supervisors of Neshannock Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Service Code (35 Pa. C.S. § 7501), as amended, does hereby extend its proclamation of the existence of a disaster emergency in the Township of Neshannock, as a result of COVID-19, in effect as of the 27th day of March, 2020 emergency meeting of the Board of Supervisors.

FURTHER, the Board of Supervisors does hereby consent to a continuation of such declaration of a disaster emergency in excess of seven (7) days, with such declaration continuing in effect until terminated by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
